Withdrawals

If a Branch or Centre withdraws a team prior to the closing date for a competition, a full refund of entry fees will be made, less an administration charge of £5. Withdrawals after the closing date for this competition will not be refunded.

ABANDONMENT (FOR ALL COMPETITIONS) In the event of a competition being abandoned, for whatever reason, a refund of 50% of the entry fee will be given. In such an instance the refund process will be communicated and must be followed.

Eligibility

Mini Competition – Teams to consist of three Members. Ages to be 10 years and under on the 1st January of the competition year, with one Member to be 8 years or under on the 1st January of the competition year.

Junior Competition – Teams to consist of three Members. Ages to be 13 years and under on the 1st January of the competition year, with one Member to be 11 years or under on the 1st January of the competition year.

Senior Competition – Teams to consist of three Members. Ages to be under 25 years on the 1st January of the competition year. One Member to be 16 years and under on the 1st January of the competition year. Of the remaining two Members, one may be between 21 and 24 on the 1st January.

Entry Conditions

To be run in accordance with Pony Club Horse & Pony Care Rules 2024

Please ensure your members comply with eligibility and hat tagging rules, and responsible adult present.

Late entries may be accepted at the organiser's discretion. Late Entry Surcharge £5.

Queries may only be raised via the Secretary by the DC or their appointee. Protests / objections will be managed as per Rule 13.

Photographic Rights – competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
